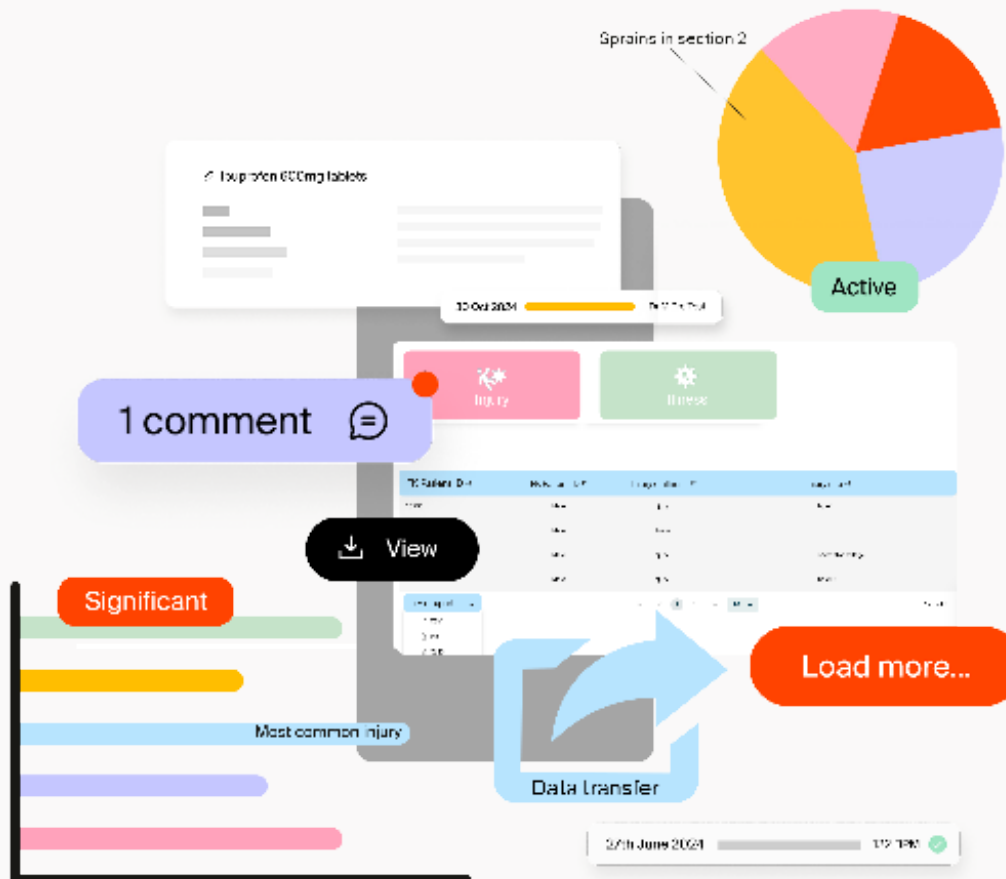

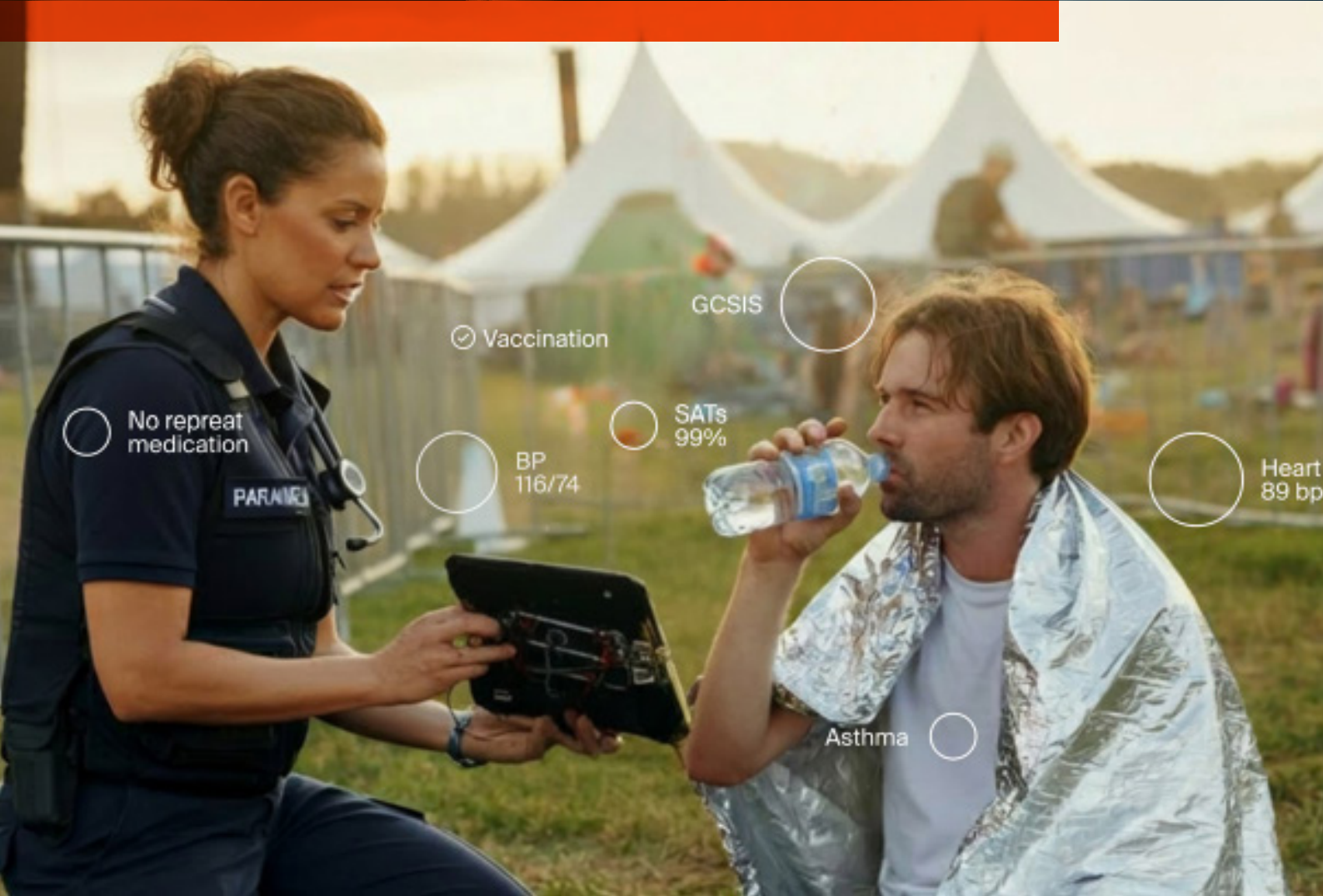
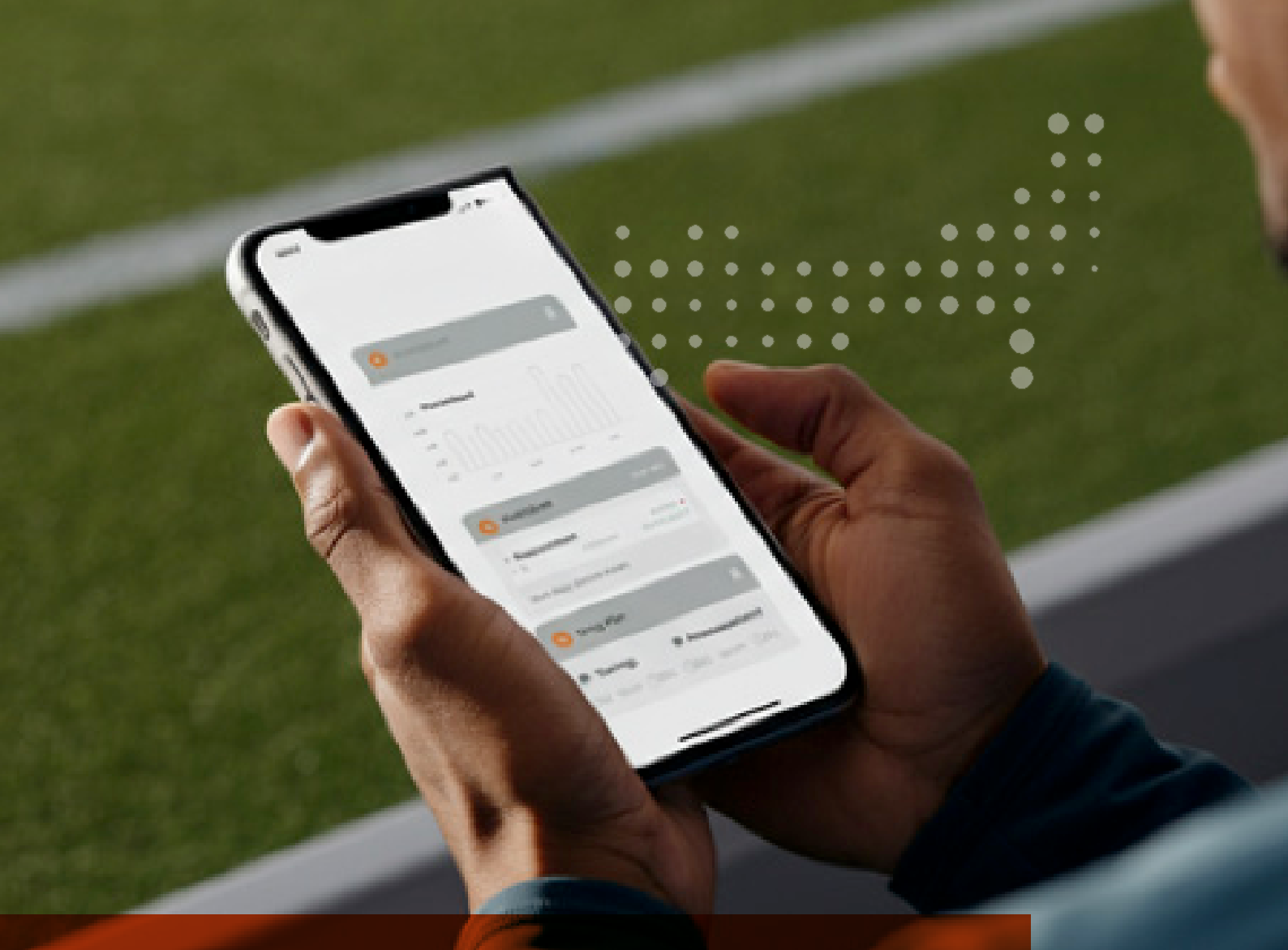
# INTRODUCING EVENT PASS - BY ORB

Imagine a world where every person at your event carries more than just a ticket. They carry a **digital health passport** that moves with them - before, during, and after the event.

ORB for Events is the world's first digital event health pass, giving attendees secure, portable access to their medical information, and giving organisers and clinicians the tools they need to act faster, smarter, and more safely when it matters most.



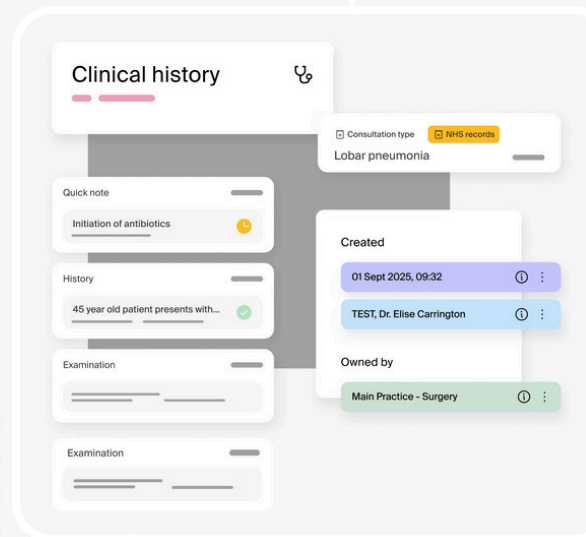




From the moment a ticket is purchased, ORB begins to work in the background, quietly collecting anonymised, tokenised health data to help organisers plan and prepare. As attendees arrive, their unique individual Event Health Pass unlocks a secure link to vital medical history. If something goes wrong, the on-site medical team can access critical information in seconds.

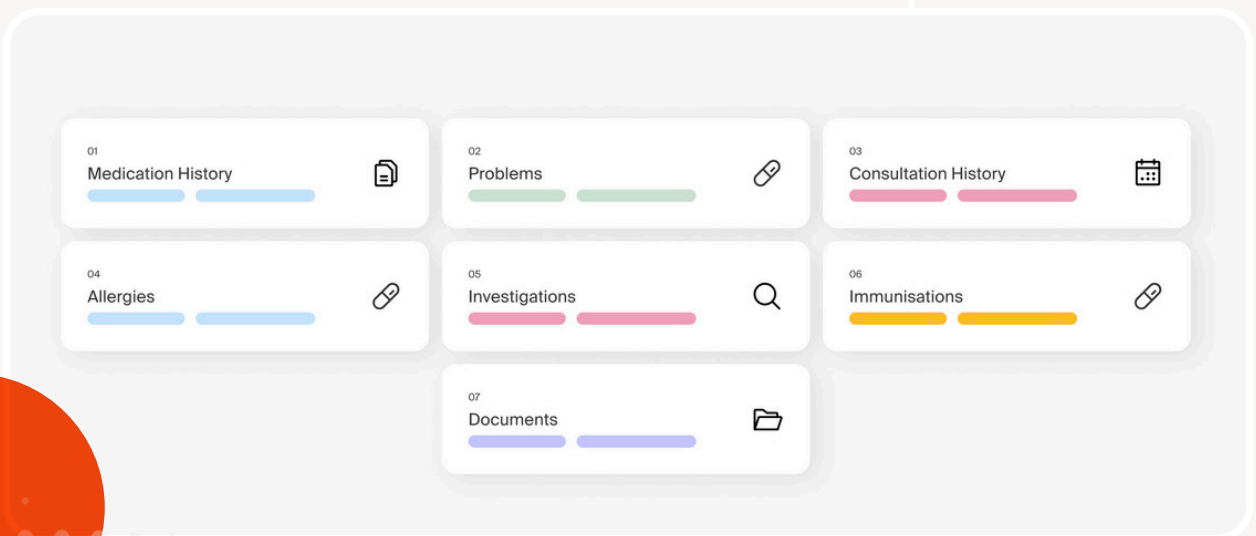


Throughout the event, Event Pass keeps a record of any medical events that happen. The platform enables medical notes, prescriptions, and referrals to be written by doctors and paramedics on site. Attendees are able to securely share their records with partner hospitals using our secondary care login portal. After the event, attendees keep all their information, and organisers receive powerful analytics to inform future planning and demonstrate value.

# HOW IT WORKS

ORB Event Pass provides every event attendee a unique number and carries their personal health information.

Event staff have access to anonymised, aggregated data before, during and after the event. They only get access to identifiable medical information when an attendee presents their Event Pass number, for the medics to access their personal records.

## flexible, seamless integration options

### BEFORE THE EVENT

ATTENDEE

#### Ticketing Process

During ticketing purchase, the attendee will be invited to enter their Event Pass number or register for one.



#### Register for Event Pass

They create Event Pass and download the app. Login to NHS/other or enter key medical information, including allergies, medications, key conditions.

### DURING THE EVENT

#### Incident Occurs

If an individual feels unwell, they can click 'Medical Attention Required' for the team to find them using GPS. Medical team enter spectator Event Pass number to access medical history and enter relevant information into Event Pass..



EVENT ORGANISER

#### Integration with Key Partners

ORB Event Pass will work with your ticketing partners for seamless onboarding as part of the ticketing process.

As spectators buy tickets, this will start to build a central profile of attendees to the event.

Pre-identified secondary care providers will be given secure access to the portal for fast management of casualties.

Event pharmacy partners will be linked to the system.

Local Public Health organisations are given login and access to the dashboard



#### Centralised Dashboard

View tokenised (anonymised), aggregated data for attendees, in line with GDPR and data protection.

This helps to give a detailed medical profile of attendees for a multi-day or multi-venue event e.g. Fifa World Cup.

View data at a holistic event level or for individual stadiums/dates to resource events based on medical data. Rationalise and justify expense.

Integrate into wider system



#### Centralised Dashboard

Monitor medical and incident reports in real time for full situational awareness.

Achieve faster response times, efficient issue resolution, and smoother event operations.



**ORB Event Pass** can standalone or can be integrated with existing health and safety systems. Through it's seamless integration with ORB for Events, it can be used as a complete medical management/electronic health records system.

ORB has a unique integration with the NHS, enabling attendees to grant access to their medical records. **ORB** is looking to work with other national health centralised record repositories globally, such as EPIC for the US.



If patient is unconscious, medical team will use SOS mode to access the code via the patients phone and make notes as to why they had to access without consent.

#### Referral to hospital

Attendee will be sent to a partner hospital, who can access medical history and notes made by on site team via secure portal & login.



#### AFTER THE EVENT



#### Event Pass record

Spectator has access to all notes, prescriptions and hospital notes from the event, which they are able to share with their clinician at home. for continuity of care.

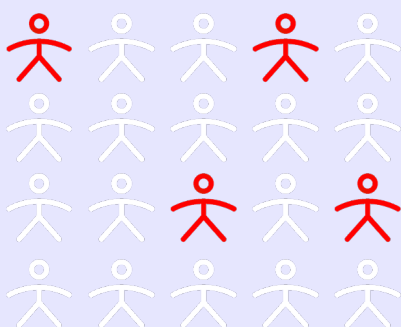
#### Mass Casualty Management

A module for effective management:

The App will alert attendees as to what is happening

Allows fast identification and triage of casualties in real time, code them red, amber, green for processing.

Monitor and deploy resources via the central dashboard.



#### Stadium Level Reporting

Audit and report on care given; time to response; on individual stadium outcomes  
e.g | 405 contacts  
| 3 sent to hospital

#### Informed Planning

Use individual reports to plan care provision for remaining event dates/locations.

#### Total Event Reporting

Run reports on overall event care provision  
| Analyse ROI  
| Report effectiveness  
| Identify cost savings

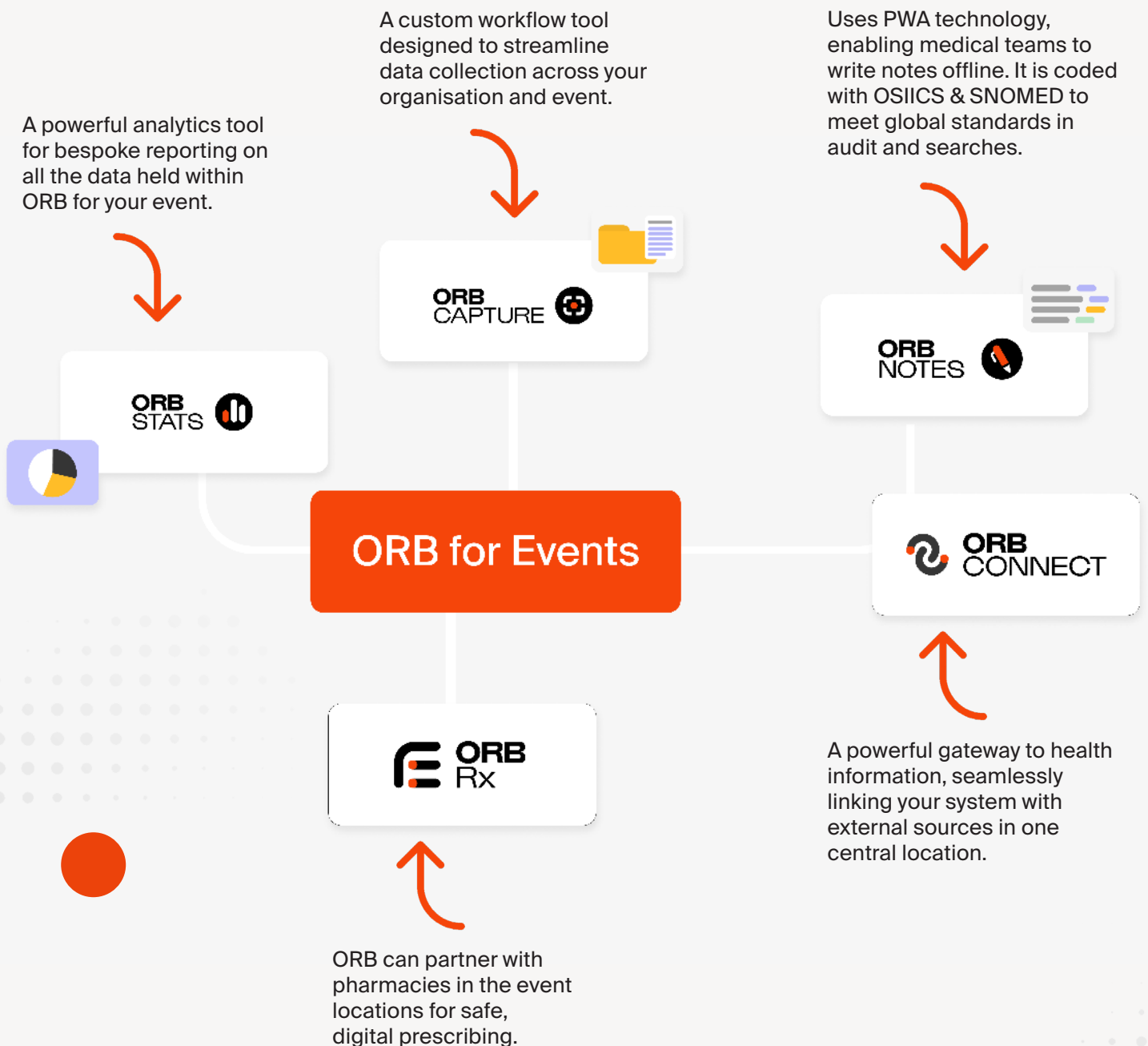


# A MODULAR, FLEXIBLE PLATFORM


ORB for Events is a purpose built medical management system, designed for major events, providing real time health information before, during and after events.

It has been designed and built for integration. It integrates with ORB Event Pass, seamlessly moving data in and out. It integrates with event management platforms e.g. Raven - <https://ravencontrols.com/>.

ORB for Events is a modular system that provides seamless access through a central, secure platform with each module created to meet event medical information needs:

# PROFESSIONAL GOLF EVENTS

ORB for Events was developed in conjunction with elite sports and has been used at professional golf events around the world, attended by more than 500,000 spectators and with over 3,500 incidents recorded.

| ORB for Events provides the medical team with the facility to document, refer and prescribe on site (even offline)

| Real time information and structured reports are accessible in real time from the medical centre to the Event Health & Safety team.

| The local Public Health team have a login to view the dashboard and access real time information

| Spectators get a copy of all medical documentation from the event.
